Essentials and Middle School students have their grades posted on engrade. Please be aware that is updated by different teachers at different times. Teachers using this system will send home a code that parents input into engrade to see their child's progress. Parents can see assignments that have been completed, those that are missing and track testing. When you sign up it also allows teacher to email you directly.

Wikis are a teacher page with information about assignments, upcoming events, help links to games and activities and homework. Parents can use the AmeriSchools site to check every classroom from Readiness through Middle School.
